- Establishing rockery with indigenous plants, and will use learners create that under the supervision of the educators.

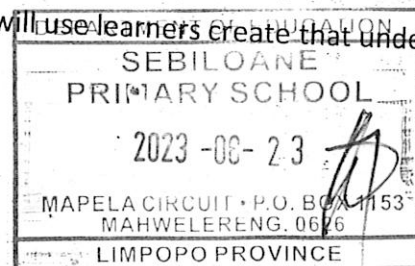
OUR MAIN AIM

1.
